CALENDAR SHARING - 2 WAY

In a previous post we have [create calendar snippets in ics format](#). [PHPicalendar](#) is the ultimate solution to stitch these calendar snippets together to a workgroup view.

I am using the built-in RSS feed to be noticed about any forthcoming events that are not sitting in my own calendar.

There is only one drawback: phpicalendar doesn't offer any possibility to import back any new meeting into Sunbird or Outlook. By using the following patch of events.php it may, however, send you back an .ics file (that can open Sunbird automatically if configured correctly) by just clicking on any new event.
