In response to growing concern over the inability to replicate many studies, John Ioannidis and Steven Goodman have founded a center in the Department of Health Research and Policy at Stanford University. The newly minted Meta-Research Innovation Center (METRICS) has set an ambitious agenda for itself: to identify and minimize "persistent threats to biomedical/scientific research quality".
